About Our Speaker, the Seminar & the Convener

Our Speaker Mr. Justice Barnabas Fung graduated from UNSW with double degrees in B.Com. and LL.B. in 1985. He was a barrister at the Hong Kong Bar before joining the Judiciary as a Magistrate, then District Judge and Chief District Judge (during which time the jurisdiction of the District Court was raised from HK\$120,000 to HK\$1 million), now a Judge of the High Court. He is currently the Judge in charge of the Personal Injury List.

Barnabas (as he is more so known to his fellow UNSW Alumni) has all along been an active member of the UNSW Law Alumni Hong Kong Chapter since his return to Hong Kong. Having served the Law Alumni Hong Kong Chapter as its coordinator for five consecutive years until 2008, Barnabas only passed on the buck to take up the more demanding role of the President of the UNSW Alumni in Hong Kong, another Honourary office he is now holding.

On 17th February 2009, Barnabas gave a seminar on the CJR organized by the Medico Legal Society, when the room was filled with over 130 enthusiastic practitioners, Senior and Junior Counsel, Solicitors of a wide spread of seniorities alike. That seminar was well received by all who attended.

In light of the CJR starting on 2nd April 2009, Barnabas has very kindly initiated this Seminar as a re-run of the one held on 17th February 2009, with added references to Mediation in the overall road map of CJR and relevant aspects regarding the Personal Injury List.

The Seminar is jointly put together by the UNSW Law Alumni Hong Kong Chapter and the F.A.A.A., as an opportunity to enhance networking among the Alumni community in Hong Kong, and also to hear more from Barnabas on the Civil Justice Reform that will come into effect on 2nd April 2009, on mediation and on the Personal Injury List, so as to better equip for the challenges coming with the CJR and the string of amended or new Practice Directions that follow.

Our Convener Henry Wong graduated from UNSW with double degrees in B.Com, LL.B. in 1989 and has since 1990 been practicing in personal injury, insurance defence as a solicitor in Hong Kong. Henry has been running his own firm Henry H.C. Wong & Co. since 1998. With the CJR round the corner, one major focus of his firm is to promote within the insurance industry the adoption of Mediation as the core mode of resolving differences in day to day claims.
